There are currently 32 of 34 turbines at various stages of turbine assembly. Of these 32 turbines, 29 have been topped to the hub, 20 of those have been erected with a completed blade set. There are still over 190 people working on the project daily and there have been approximately 345,000 man hours clocked to date.

TURBINE DELIVERIES

Due to winter weather we have asked the component truck drivers to drive slowly and ask that local drivers use the same caution when approaching the delivery trucks.

A big thank you goes to local residents for being so patient while we deliver our final turbines to site.
