Though the conditions are cold and windy, our construction team continues to make good progress onsite.

Currently, we have **27 turbines** in various stages of assembly, of which **eleven turbines** are completely erected. See the progress from the top of this turbine nacelle!



To erect the turbines, we have a new crane on-site that was shipped from Germany to the Halifax Harbour Port. It is the Liebherr LG I750, capable of lifting 750 Metric Tonnes. Take a look!





Our site workers have now clocked 310,000 person-hours and we have over 200 people working on-site.
